## **CLERK'S REPORT OCTOBER 2023**

The Parish Council met on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2023, the meeting was attended by seven Councillors, Cllr Hales (WDC) and three members of the public.

The Council would like to thank those who have already sent in the locations of stiles on public footpaths around the Parish. We are building up a map of stiles in the area, if you know of any stiles on footpaths near you, please do send the location details into the Clerk – using what3words.com on a smart phone makes it very easy to record an accurate location.

The Council owns eight noticeboards across the Parish, several of which have been in place for many years and are due some care and attention. The Council have agreed a renovation plan for five of our noticeboards; your local board may disappear for a while, but it will eventually return fully restored. The Council's glazed noticeboard outside the village hall is to be replaced.

Warwick District Council is carrying out a review of their polling districts and polling places and is inviting comments from residents regarding the convenience of location and accessibility of your local polling station.
