- b. **Proposed Traveller Site** Norton Lindsey/Shrebourne this had attracted most attention at the Forum with a large number of people coming only for this item. The potential for a site on the hard standing that remained from the works at the A46/M40 junction 15 was being explored but there were questions as to whether the noise level and light pollution would make it suitable. The Chairman advised that due to an oversight the Clerk's salary had not been reviewed since her appointment and it was proposed to move her salary with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2009 to the pro rata equivalent to spinal column point 21 to more closely reflect what neighbouring Parishes were paying. This would be reviewed in January of each year as per the Clerk's contract. In terms of this year's budget this would be approximately an additional £250 and the impact on the 2010/2011 budget this would be an increase of approximately £750.
