MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF LAPWORTH PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON MONDAY 10th May 2010 AT LAPWORTH VILLAGE HALL, OLD WARWICK ROAD, LAPWORTH AT 7.30 PM.

12. WARWICK DISTRICT COUNCIL

District Councillor Caborn advised that the exhumation of bodies had started in preparation for the conversion of the Unitarian Chapel to a theatre in Leamington. Warwick, Leamington and Stratford Tourist Information Centres had been closed due to insolvency and measures were being looked at to see what could replace them. Lean Systems thinking and joint working with Stratford DC were being looked at to explore the opportunities for financial savings without service cuts.
