Cllr Mrs Gallagher and Cllr Whiting were welcomed to their first meeting of Lapworth Parish Council

The District Council's Local Plan had been referred back as not sound and concerns had been expressed by the Inspector regarding the forecast of windfall developments and the unallocated number of housing proposals at a sub regional level. The Leader of Warwick District Council was lobbying MP's to minimise delays. Concern was expressed by Parish Councillors regarding the investment already made in the local plan and detriment that the delay in having an adopted Local Plan could cause. An assurance was given the there was the presumption that Green Belt would be protected.

- a. Warwickshire County Council Small Scale Flood Alleviation Grant Scheme The Parish Council supported and bid by the proprietor of Willpower Garage for grant funding to assist in the work currently being undertaken to alleviate localized flooding.
- b. **Notice of Application for and Order Stopping up Part of the Public Highway at Bushwood Lane** Receipt acknowledged by the Parish Council of a notice to stop up part of the highway, adjoining Bushwood Cottage, which is no longer necessary for public use, due to this part of the highway not having been used as highway. Cllr Mrs Compton advised that the order was being made in response to ongoing concerns regarding motorcycle usage.
