16/11/2 **Declarations of Interest** – Cllr Mrs Toogood and Cllr Giles declared a personal interest in W16/1767 to build a new dwelling adjacent to Inglewood. Cllr Henderson declared a personal interest in item 8c as until recently was a member of the Council of the Canal River Trust

16/11/4 **Public Participation** Fraser Pithie a Canal and River Trust volunteer was present in relation to item 8.c highlighting that the towpath between Boot and Kingswood Junction was at times non negotiable at times of bad weather. He was leading an application for funding with Canal and River Trust and the District Council's Rural and Urban Capital Improvements Grant.

Warwick District Council District Councillor Mrs Gallagher reported that as part of the refurbishment programme of the Leisure Centres it was likely that both Newbold Comyn Leisure Centre and St Nicholas Park swimming pool are likely to be closed for 22 weeks. Examination of the Local Plan was continuing with a likely outcome in the spring of 2017. The review of funding available to the Parish Council for concurrent services and rate support was likely to go ahead as put forward.
- b. Warwickshire County Council County Councillor Mrs Compton highlighted the Warwickshire Health Transport scheme which provides transport for people to attend medical appointments. responses had been received in relation to the school parking consultation. Details of Community Forum Grants had been circulated.

c. Warwick Rural West Community Forum – LPC response to consultation regarding future of the Community Forum 'Lapworth Parish Council response values the opportunity that the Warwick Rural West Forum offers to share concerns and views with neighbouring Parishes and authorities and would ideally chose to keep it. However it appreciates the increasing financial pressures facing local government so if the levels of communication and access to grants are kept open via alternative channels it has no objection to change.'
