'This is a difficult situation due to the Old Warwick Road being a B class road and the lack of street lighting meaning that any physical traffic calming features would not be possible. I think Clive Henderson from the Parish response below sums the situation up perfectly and the Police will not have the resources to enforce the speed limits unfortunately. I can also confirm that there hasn't been any recent injury road traffic collisions for the sections mentioned. I am

however happy to re-visit this section of road to see if there are any minor schemes possible including measures such as gateway features, roundel markings, extra repeater signs which we can install on a non street lit roads?'
